Why Should I Attend????

- To ring with other handbell ensembles who love handbell ringing too

Who May Attend

- This festival is designed for full or partial handbell ensembles as well as individual handbell ringers of high school age and adults.
- Handbell ensembles must learn the festival music prior to coming.

Registration

- Due to space limitations, the number of registrants will be limited, so register early!!!
- Significant discounts are offered for early registrations.
- Director Registration: \$65
- Ringer Registration: \$75 (if postmarked /entered online by October 31, 2025)
- Ringer Registration: \$80 (if postmarked/entered online by January 15, 2026)
- Ringer Registration: \$110 (if postmarked/entered online after January 15, 2026)
- ♦ HMA membership is NOT required. If you are currently not a member and would like to join, you will have that option as part of registration. HMA Membership − add \$95 (optional).
- You have a choice of registering & paying online or registering and paying by check through the mail.
- When sending in your registration form, please include only one (1) check from your organization with full payment partial payments will not be accepted.

- The Registrar will acknowledge registration within two weeks of receipt.

Refund Policy

- \$25 per registrant is nonrefundable when requested prior to January 15, 2026. After that date, there will be no refunds regardless of reason including medical issues and family emergencies.

Classes

- This year, the Area 3 Board decided to change the format of this festival. The Guest Conductor, Kathryn Jurado, will be leading two classes during the massed ringing rehearsals.
- There will be a special Director's Track for ALL directors. See Director's Track brochure.

NEW THIS YEAR - DIRECTOR'S TRACK

- While your ringers are rehearsing, the Area 3 Board has designed two ringing tracks for ALL directors whether you bring a choir/ensemble to the festival or not.
- See the Director's Track Brochure for all the details.

Repertoire

- Purchase the repertoire from your favorite handbell music supplier.
- Photocopied music is NOT permitted.
- Learn the repertoire in advance. Rehearsal notes will be included in the Information Packet that will be sent to you after you register.
- On the registration form, please check the box if your choir will be ringing the Challenge Piece *Campanae Celebrare*.
- Area 3 had a winner in the 2025 Composition Contest. This piece, *Rondo Giubilo*, is included in this year's repertoire. This piece will NOT be published until after the event. You will receive one copy in the Information Packet that you will receive after you register. You will be responsible for making copies for your choir. These copies will only be for the festival. After the festival, you will need to destroy your copies and purchase the piece from your favorite music supplier.

Tables

- Tables will be supplied by the convention center.
- All choirs will ring in a straight line.
- On the registration form, please note the amount of table footage that you need.
- Choirs must bring pads, notebooks or music racks, bells, chimes, mallets, gloves. Table covers and skirts are optional. All equipment must be clearly marked!

Layout of Massed Ringing Area

- All choirs will ring in a straight row (there is no room to turn any tables).
- Since the Rehoboth Beach Convention Center is much smaller than the previous location, choirs may need to be divided into two rows.

Parking

- Since the convention center is located four blocks from the ocean and on the main road to the beach, parking is going to be limited.
- Please have your group carpool as much as possible.
- There is NOT a lot of space for large church vans in the parking lot.
- You may need to use on-street parking.
- Good Thing you will NOT need to pay the parking meters in March!!!!!

Meals

- NO meals are included in your registration fee.
- A list of restaurants will be provided in your registration packet for Friday dinner & Saturday lunch.

Individuals without a choir

- An opportunity will be provided for individuals who wish to ring in the festival by filling vacancies offered by other choirs, on an available basis, or by bringing bells and pads.
- Individuals will ring the same repertoire as the massed choirs and participate in the festival concert.
- If you are a director with vacant positions, please indicate the positions available on the Registration Form.

Lodging

- There is not an official festival hotel.
- There are many different hotels near the convention center and along Route 1.

About the Clinician - Kathryn Jurado



A musician with over 30 years of performance experience, 20 years of non-profit volunteer work, and lifelong church music ministry service, **Kathryn Jurado** has quickly gained prominence in the handbell community as a ringer and director. She is starting her first year as the Director of Handbell Activities at Landon School in Bethesda, Maryland, where she will lead students from grades 5 through 12. Kathryn also serves as President-Elect on the national board of Handbell Musicians of America, and is the Handbell and Instrumental Editor of Alfred Handbell, a division of Jubilate Music Group.

Originally born in Puerto Rico, Kathryn holds both a Bachelor and Master of Music degree from the University of South Florida in Tampa. As a freelance oboist and

private teacher, she has performed with groups such as Opera Tampa, the Venice Symphony, The Tampa Bay Symphony, The Villages Philharmonic, and performances of La La Land Live, and with Ray Charles, the Irish Tenors, and pop superstars Hanson.

Previously, Kathryn served as one of the music directors and Vice President of Magic of Bronze, a community handbell ensemble based in the Orlando area, which was one of the featured performance choirs at the 2020 HMA National Seminar, as well as a term as Associate Director of the Suncoast Bronze Ringers community handbell ensemble in the Tampa Bay area. Kathryn also led a handbell ensemble at the University of South Florida, taught music in the Hillsborough County Public Schools for over a decade, served as Province Officer with Sigma Alpha Iota, International Music Fraternity, and was the handbell director at Lake Magdalene Church (formerly UMC) in Tampa.

In 2022, Kathryn had the privilege to be the clinician for Reaching for Bronze (now known as Crescendo) in New Bern, North Carolina. Most recently, she was the handbell clinician for the Florida Chapter of the Fellowship of Worship Artists' Worship Arts Week in Fruitland Park, Florida in 2024 and 2025, HMA Area 4's Bells of the Caribbean in 2024, HMA's 2025 College Ring-In, and the 2025 Utah Spring Ring. Kathryn was a faculty member at HMA's 2025 Pinnacle event in Wichita, Kansas, and is looking forward to leading handbell festivals in Delaware, Montana, and Nebraska in 2026.

In her spare time, Kathryn, along with her husband, William J. Murphy, enjoys traveling to Disney, cruising the Caribbean, and watching movies with their clowder of cats.
