GENERAL INFORMATION

Who May Attend

- This festival is designed for full or partial handbell ensembles as well as individual handbell ringers of high school age and adults.
- **Handbell ensembles must learn the festival music prior to coming.**

Registration

- Significant discounts are offered for early registrations.
- Registration: \$75 per person (if postmarked /entered online by October 31, 2026)
- Registration: \$85 per person (if postmarked/entered online by January 15, 2027)
- Registration: \$110 per person (if postmarked/entered online after January 15, 2027)
- HMA membership is NOT required. If you are currently not a member and would like to join, you will have that option as part of registration. HMA Membership – add \$95 (optional).
- You have a choice of registering & paying online or registering and paying by check through the mail.
- **When sending in your registration form, please include only one (1) check from your organization with full payment - partial payments will not be accepted.**
- **Make your check payable to *Handbell Musicians of America Area 3* and mail to Gail Williams, Registrar - 7903 Glenbrook Rd., Bethesda, MD 20814.**
- The Registrar will acknowledge registration within two weeks of receipt.

Cancellation Policy

- Cancellations may be made through **January 15, 2027**. For cancellations received by this date, a partial refund of the registration fee will be issued, less a \$25 administration fee. No refunds will be issued for registrations cancelled after January 15, 2027.
- Please note that any processing fees charged by TicketSignUp for online registrations are non-refundable and online registrations are subject to the full \$25 administration fee.

Tables

- Tables will be supplied by the convention center.
- Indicate on the registration form if you are **bringing** your own tables or **need tables**.
- All choirs will ring in a straight line.
- Choirs must bring pads, notebooks or music racks, bells, chimes, mallets, gloves. Table covers and skirts are optional. All equipment must be clearly marked!

Layout of Massed Ringing Area

- All choirs will ring in a straight row (there is no room to turn any tables).
- Since the Rehoboth Beach Convention Center is much smaller than the previous location, choirs may need to be divided into two rows.

Parking

- Since the convention center is located four blocks from the ocean and on the main road to the beach, parking is going to be limited. You may need to use on-street parking.
- Please have your group carpool as much as possible.
- There is NOT a lot of space for large church vans in the parking lot.
- Good Thing - you will NOT need to pay the parking meters in March!!!!

Meals

- Meals are **NOT** included in your registration.
- A list of restaurants will be provided at the registration table. Many are within walking distance of the convention center.

Individuals without a choir

- An opportunity will be provided for directors or individuals who wish to ring in the festival by filling vacancies offered by other choirs, on an available basis, or by bringing bells and pads.
- Individuals will ring the same repertoire as the massed choirs and participate in the festival concert.
- If you are a director with vacant positions, please indicate the positions available on the Registration Form.

Solo Performance Opportunity

- Ensembles will be given the opportunity to perform a solo of their choice during the final concert.
- This opportunity is limited to the first five (5) ensembles that register.
- If your ensemble is interested in performing, please check the box on the registration form.
- The title, composer and arranger will be due by **January 31, 2027**.

Silent Auction

- In order to further Area 3's goal of promoting handbell ringing, we are holding Silent Auctions at Area 3 events in order to raise monies for events such as Blast Off to Bells. So, we ask you to bring something to place in the Silent Auction at the monetary value of at least \$30 - CDs, gift certificates, a gift basket from your choir, sealed food items, etc. Please let Debbie Henning know prior to the festival what you are bringing. Your donation will help Area 3 be a leader in handbells into the future!

Classes

- Registrants will have the opportunity of taking two classes during the event - Saturday morning and Saturday afternoon.
- The Class Pre-Registration Packet will be emailed to you after you register for this festival.

Lodging

- There is **NO** official festival hotel. There are many lodging options in Rehoboth Beach.

Photography Policy

- By registering for an Area 3 event, you give permission to use pictures from the event on the Area 3 website, on the Area 3 Social Media, and in future publications. Individuals will NOT be identified or pictured in potentially embarrassing situations. About the Clinician – Stephanie (Stevie) Berryman



Stevie Berryman lights up festival podiums with her humor, creativity, and ability to draw moving performances out of ringers at any skill level. She is the director of the Handbell Ensemble at Trinity University and the Artistic Director of River City Ringers in San Antonio. She wears the titles of handbell clinician, arranger, and educator but is best known for her imaginative and immersive concert programming.

A self-professed “technique geek,” Stevie has a particular passion for teaching beginners how to ring, and her innovative, play-based methods have made her a sought-after educator and clinician at area, national, and international handbell festivals. She loves helping other choirs as a private clinician or planning epic concerts for them as a creative consultant. She and her husband Paul are co-owners of Truly Horrible Things, a snarky card game company, even though her mother always told her that no one would ever pay her to be sarcastic.

About the Opening Concert Performers – Wilmington Handbell Ensemble



Our mission is to entertain as well as to inspire through music. Founded in 2000, by Michael Helman, the ensemble is committed to fostering a love of handbell music and encouraging the next generation to continue the art of handbell ringing. Among a select few community choirs in the Delaware Valley, the ensemble has performed at Longwood Gardens, with the Newark Symphony Orchestra,

at the Brandywine River Museum, in Old New Castle, South Jersey, eastern Maryland and more. Besides performing for both public and private concerts, ensemble members have offered both formal and impromptu “hands on bells” clinics.

The ensemble plays six octaves of bronze, Schulmerich handbells and six octaves of Malmrk choirchimes, accompanied by a variety of other percussion and wind instruments. All together their full orchestral sounds captivates audiences young and old.

Scholarship to the Beach Festival

The Area 3 Board will be offering two scholarships to the Piedmont Festival. To apply for a \$100 scholarship, all applicants:

- Must be part of an organization that is a member in good standing of Handbell Musicians of America
- Must be a resident of Area 3 at the time of the application and the event
- Must be registered for the festival

On the application, the applicant will:

- Assess how attendance will benefit the applicant, their handbell program, and the broader ringing community,
- Assess how the experience supports the mission and goals of Area 3

If chosen for a scholarship, the Scholarship winners will:

- submit a written report on their experience at the event for inclusion in Area 3 communications
